

CABLED STOCKING HAT

Materials Needed: 2 skeins Sirdar Nova or Sirdar Super Nova (or, any comparable chunky weight yarn)
#8 U.S. circular needle 24" long
#8 U.S. double pointed needles

Cast on 100 stitches. Being careful not to twist, join yarn and do K2P2 ribbing for 28 rounds. (If you wish to have a contrasting strip in the ribbing, rib for 4 rounds, use contrasting yarn for the next 6 rounds and then return to main color for the rest of the hat.)

Round 29 and 30: *K4, P3, K10, P3 repeat from * four more times

Round 31: *K4, P3, CB5, P3 repeat from * four more times

(Repeat Round 29 for the next 11 rounds then do Round 31) twice

Repeat Round 29 seven times

Next Round: K2tog all the way around changing to double pointed needles at the same time. There will be 50 stitches left.

Knit 3 rounds

Next Round: K2tog all the way around

Cut yarn leaving a 6" tail. Pull yarn tightly thru remaining stitches and secure. Add pom-pom if desired.
